EXPLANATORY STATEMENT DETERMINATION OF A PLACE TO BE A SPORTS BOOKMAKING VENUE INSTRUMENT NO. 272 OF 2001

Outline

The *Race and Sports Bookmakers Act 2001* (the Act) governs the activities of sports bookmakers in the Australian Capital Territory.

Part 3 of the Act provides for the conduct and control of sports bookmaking. In particular, the legislation empowers the Commission to determine a place to be a sports bookmaking venue.

Section 21(1) of the Act provides that the Commission may determine a place to be a sports bookmaking venue for the purpose of the Act.

This instrument determines the same sports bookmaking venue approved pursuant to Determination No. 338 of 2000, notified in Gazette No W45 of 9 November 2000, of the repealed *Bookmakers Act 1985*.

The sports bookmaking venue this determination relates to is the place where the mobile sales caravan, owned and operated by ACTTAB Limited, registration number T73975, may be located from time to time.

Financial Implications
