SURVEYORS (EXAMINATION AND REGISTRATION) REGULATIONS (AMENDMENT)

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

No. 15 of 1982

The Surveyors Ordinance 1967 makes provision for the registration of land surveyors and the regulation of the practice of land surveying in the Territory. The Surveyors (Examination and Registration) Regulations set out conditions for persons entering into articles with registered surveyors, details for examinations and qualifications for registration and also prescribe related fees.

The Surveyors (Examination and Registration) Regulations (Amendment) increases from 1 July 1982 the prescribed fees as set out below –
