EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

INSTRUMENT NO. 256 OF 2001

APPOINTMENT TO THE CLEANING INDUSTRY LONG SERVICE LEAVE BOARD

The Cleaning Industry Long Service Leave Board was established by section 5 of the *Long Service Leave (Cleaning, Building and Property Services) Act 1999* ("the Act"). Section 5 commenced on 23 December 1999.

Subsection 10(1) of the Act, which also commenced on 23 December 1999, stipulates that the Board shall consist of (a) the Chairperson; (b) a member representing employer organisations; and (c) a member representing employee organisations.

By subsection 10(2) of the Act, which also commenced on 23 December 1999, the members of the Board are to be appointed by the Minister and shall hold office for up to 5 years, as stated in the member's appointment. Section 11 of the Act enables the Minister to appoint acting members of the Board, who may act in place of the appointed member for up to one year during the member's absence.

The following are instruments of appointment for Rodney Barnes as a member of the Board and Sue Price Arcidiacono as acting member of the Board, effective from the date of Gazettal to 14 July 2003.

Pursuant to section 4 of the *Statutory Appointments Act 1994*, these appointments were endorsed by the Legislative Assembly's Standing Committee on Planning and Urban Services on 20 June 2001.
