BOILERS AND PRESSURE VESSELS REGULATIONS

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

No. 33 of 1982

The Boilers and Pressure Vessels Regulations (Amendment) amend regulation 39 and the Schedule to the Boilers and Pressures Vessels Regulations by increasing the fees for the issue of a boiler attendant's certificate and for the inspection of boilers and pressure vessels.

Details of the former and new fees are set out below.

Regulation 1 amends regulation 39 as follows:
