WEIGHTS AND MEASURES REGULATIONS

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

No. 40 of 1982

The Weights and Measures Regulations (Amendment) amends the Weights and Measures Regulations made pursuant to the Weights and Measures Ordinance 1929 to increase various fees and charges.

The Schedule to the Weights and Measures Regulations is amended to increase fees as follows:
