TAXI AND PRIVATE HIRE CAR REGULATIONS

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

No. 21 of 1983

The Taxi and private Hire Car Regulations (Amendment) (the amending Regulations) amends the Taxi and Private Hire Car Regulations (the principal Regulations) to increase taxi fares.

Regulation 1 of the amending Regulations amends regulation 24 of the principal regulations by increasing the fees in relation to taxi hire as set out in the Table:

Regulation 2 of the amending Regulations amends Schedule 2 to the Principal Regulations, which specifies a notice which taxi drivers are required to display in their taxis, by omitting the previous fees and inserting the new fees as shown in the Table.
