EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

No. 12 of 1968

The amendment –

- (a) brings the scale of solicitor's costs in workmen's compensation cases in line with the scale of costs applying in other jurisdictions of the Court of Petty Sessions, and
- (b) in workmen's compensation cases involving amounts normally beyond the limit of the jurisdiction of the Court of Petty Sessions, makes a commensurate increase in the scale of solicitor's costs.
