EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

Special provisions are being introduced to exclude guide dogs as far as possible from restrictive legislation. This has necessitated the amendment of the Dogs Registration Ordinance 1926–1967, the Motor Omnibus Regulations and the Commonwealth Motor Omnibus Services Regulations. The amendments to the Regulations allow a blind person to be accompanied by his guide dog when travelling on a bus. The only stipulation is that the dog must wear an identification disc issued under section 7 of the Dogs Registrations Ordinance 1926-1967.
