Explanatory Memorandum

Amendment of Public Health (Dairy) Regulations

No. 5 of 1963

Milk vendors in the Australian Capital Territory are permitted to deliver milk and cream to households only between the hours of 11 p.m. and 7.30 a.m.

The purpose of the amendment is to advance the commencing time to 9 p.m. in the months June, July, August and September when temperatures are low enough to ensure that this concession to vendors could not result in any deterioration in the quality of the milk so delivered.
