Dangerous Goods (Fees) Revocation and Determination 2003 (No 1)

Disallowable Instrument DI 2003—77

made under the

Dangerous Goods Act 1975, Part 7, Section 46 – Determination of fees

The *Dangerous Goods Act 1975* regulates the import, manufacture, transport, storage, handling, sale and use of dangerous goods in the ACT. Section 46 of the Act gives the Minister the power to determine fees.

This Instrument revokes fees determined for the 2002-03 financial year and determines new fees. Fees for licences to sell shopgoods fireworks classified under Regulation 41A as suitable for retail sale during the Queen's Birthday sale period have been restructured as has the fee for the permit to purchase shopgoods fireworks during the Queen's Birthday sale period.

This Instrument takes effect from 27 May 2003.
