DETERMINATION OF FEES

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

**THE PUBLIC HEALTH ACT 1997 ('THE ACT') PROVIDES FOR THE
LICENSING OF PUBLIC HEALTH RISK ACTIVITIES.**

The Act empowers the Minister under section 137, by notice published in the Gazette, to determine fees for the purposes of the Act.

This instrument sets the fees for the licensing of the licensable public health risk activity – the operation of an Infection Control Business. The fees have been determined at the same level as the previous determination made under the *Skin Penetration Procedures Act 1994*.
