Public Health (Fees) Determination 2013 (No 1)

Disallowable instrument DI2013-30

made under the

Public Health Act 1997, s 137 (Determination of fees)

The *Public Health Act 1997* provides for the licensing and registration of public health risk activities. This instrument sets fees for the application, renewal and transfer of all licensable or registrable public health risk activities. The fee were last set by DI 2012-235, which came into effect on 1 November 2012.

Due to an inadvertent error in preparing DI 2012-235, a fee exemption for Cooling Tower & Warm Water Storage licence, renewal and transfer for a charity was removed. This instrument restores the fee exemption for this category. The opportunity has been taken to review the instrument for any other grammatical and typographical errors, including moving the definitions from a schedule to the instrument itself. No fee-exempt registration has been affected by the inadvertent error.

There has been no change made to the fees determined under DI 2012-235. The instrument provides for the revocation of DI 2012-235.
