Road Transport (Driver Licensing) Alcohol Ignition Interlock Devices Approval 2014

Notifiable instrument NI2014–262

made under the

Road Transport (Driver Licensing) Regulation 2000 - (Approval of alcohol ignition interlock devices - S73ZL)

Explanatory Statement

The ACT Alcohol Ignition Interlock Program comes into effect on 17 June 2014.

Under section 73ZL of the *Road Transport (Driver Licensing) Regulation 2000* (the Regulation) the Road Transport Authority may approve an alcohol ignition interlock device.

The interlock device is required to comply with Australian Standard AS 3547-1997 (Breath Alcohol Testing Devices for Personal Use).

Clause 3 of the instrument provides that the following interlock devices are approved:

Dräger Interlock XT

Alcolock WR3

Smartstart Model SSI 20/20

Smartstart Model SSI 20/30
