Road Transport (Safety and Traffic Management) Regulation 2000, section 75A(2) (Parking Authorities)

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

Subsection 75A(2) of the *Road Transport (Safety and Traffic Management) Regulation* 2000 (the Regulation) permits the Road Transport Authority to declare a person to be a Parking Authority which may establish and operate a ticket parking scheme for any length of road or area under its control in accordance the Road Transport (Safety and Traffic Management) Guidelines 2002. Subsection 75A(3) of the Regulation makes such a declaration a disallowable instrument.

Coles Group Property Developments Limited applied to the Road Transport Authority to be a Parking Authority for the area Block 21 Section 30 in the suburb Dickson.

The new disallowable instrument effects the declaration by the Road Transport Authority for Coles Group Property Developments Limited as a Parking Authority for the identified area.

This disallowable instrument also repeals DI2009-123 (which is about Wilson Parking Australia 1992 Pty Ltd and Blocks 19 and 20, Section 63, City) dated 24 June 2009.
