DOG CONTROL ACT 1975

INSTRUMENT NO. 100 OF 2001

DETERMINATION FEES

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The *Dog Control Act 1975* (the *Act*) is the current legislation that manages domestic animal issues in the ACT.

Section 40A of the *Act* provides for the Minister to, by notice in the Gazette, determine fees payable under the *Act*.

This instrument determines the fees for the initial registration of a dog for the period of 1 June 2001 to 20 June 2001 inclusive. It temporarily replaces determination number 173 of 2000 for the stated period.

The purpose of the determination is to provide free initial dog registration as a means of promoting the *Animal Welfare (Amendment) Act 2000* and the *Domestic Animals Act 2000*, and as a means of increasing dog registration.

The determination is a disallowable instrument for the purposes of section 10 of the *Subordinate Laws Act 1989*.
