Road Transport (Safety and Traffic Management) Parking Authority Declaration 2014 (No 3)

Disallowable instrument DI2014—267

made under the

Road Transport (Safety and Traffic Management) Regulation 2000, section 75A (2) (Parking authorities)

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

Subsection 75A(2) of the *Road Transport (Safety and Traffic Management) Regulation 2000* (the Regulation) permits the Road Transport Authority to declare a person to be a Parking Authority for a stated area. A Parking Authority may establish and operate a ticket parking scheme for that stated area in accordance with the Road Transport (Safety and Traffic Management) Guidelines 2002. Subsection 75A (3) of the Regulation makes such a declaration a disallowable instrument.

Link Strata Management, on behalf of Units Plan 1703, applied to the Road Transport Authority to be a Parking Authority for the area of Block 24, Section 32, Dickson (street address – 28 Challis Street Dickson).

The Disallowable Instrument effects the declaration by the Road Transport Authority for Units Plan 1703 as a Parking Authority for the identified area.
