# Gaming Machine (Fees) Determination 2015 (No 1)

### **EXPLANATORY STATEMENT**

The Gaming Machine Act 2004 (the Act) regulates the operation of gaming machines in the Territory.

This instrument revokes the determination of fees made by Disallowable Instrument DI2014-109, notified on the Legislation Register on 10 June 2014.

Section 177 of the Act provides that the Minister may determine fees for the Act. This instrument provides for fees in relation to administrative tasks performed under the Act, including applications for approvals, licences, variations to those licences and to certificates issued by the Commission.

This instrument increases fees in accordance with Government policy which is based on the Wage Price Index estimates for 2015-2016 of 2.75%. Rounding to the nearest dollar has occurred in relation to the increases. A comparative table indicating the previous and revised fees is included as an attachment to this Explanatory Statement.

The list of revised fees contained in this instrument has been amended to remove the fees associated with Approved Attendant Certificates as a result of a legislative amendment in December 2014 (previous sections 85, 89, 93 and 96 refer). All other fees are identical to those contained in the Disallowable Instrument DI2014-109.

A determination under section 177 is a disallowable instrument and must be tabled in the Legislative Assembly.
