EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The purpose of the *Construction Occupations (Licensing) Act 2004* is to regulate construction occupations and other purposes.

Section 127 of the Act provides the Minister with the power to determine fees.

The purpose of this determination is to revoke Disallowable Instrument DI 2014-153 which set fees for the 2014-15 financial year and to determine fees for the 2015-16 financial year.

The fees determined for the 2015-16 financial year represent the 2014-15 financial year fees generally increased in accordance with ACT Treasury's inflation factor of 4%. Appropriate rounding has occurred in relation to the increases.

Fees have been rounded to achieve administrative efficiencies.

The fees take effect on 1 July 2015.

The determination under section 127 of the Act is a Disallowable Instrument.
