EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

Section 40 of the *University of Canberra Act 1989* gives the university Council the power to make Statutes.

The Academic Progress Statute 1995 has been revoked and replaced by a new Statute, the University of Canberra (Academic Progress) Statute 2015. The new Statute provides a definition of academic probation and the imposition of academic probation. These definitions will help ease the administration of the regulation. A savings provision has been included to maintain decisions taken under the previous Statute.

Section 42 of the *University of Canberra Act 1989* requires that a Statute, once made by Council, be submitted by the Chancellor to the Executive for approval.
