# Cultural Facilities Corporation (Governing Board) Appointment 2015 (No 5)

## **EXPLANATORY STATEMENT**

---

The *Cultural Facilities Corporation Act 1997* establishes the Cultural Facilities Corporation Governing Board.

Governing board members of the Cultural Facilities Corporation are appointed under Section 9 of the *Cultural Facilities Corporation Act 1997* (see also Section 79 of the *Financial Management Act 1996* for appointment of deputy chair).

This instrument appoints Louise Douglas as Deputy Chair of the governing board. The appointment begins on the day after notification for a two year period.

The appointee is not a Public Servant and this instrument makes appointments to which the *Legislation Act 2001*, Division 19.3.3 applies. Accordingly, under the *Legislation Act 2001*, s.229, the instrument is a disallowable instrument.

The appointment has been approved by the Minister for the Arts, and the Standing Committee on Education, Training and Young People has been consulted in accordance with Section 228 (consultation with appropriate Assembly committee) of the *Legislation Act 2001*.

The disallowable instrument DI2015-276 – Cultural Facilities Corporation (Governing Board) Appointment 2015 (No. 2) dated 17 September 2015 and notified on the Legislation Register on 24 September 2015 is revoked.
