DOG CONTROL ACT 1975

INSTRUMENT NO. 19 OF 2001

DETERMINATION FEES

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The *Dog Control Act 1975* (the *Act*) is the current legislation that manages domestic animal issues in the ACT.

Section 40A of the *Act* provides that the Minister may, by notice in the Gazette, determine fees payable under the *Act*.

This instrument determines the fees for the initial registration of a dog within the boundaries of Exhibition Park in Canberra for the period of 23 February 2001 to 25 February 2001 inclusive. It temporarily replaces determination number 173 of 2000 within the stated area and for the stated period.

The purpose of the determination is to provide free initial dog registration to patrons of the Royal Canberra Show, as a means of promoting the *Animal Welfare Amendment Act 2000* and the *Domestic Animals Act 2000*, and as a means of increasing dog registration.

The determination is a disallowable instrument for the purposes of section 10 of the *Subordinate Laws Act 1989*.
