DECLARATION OF MAXIMUM PERIOD OF REGISTRATION FOR SEASONAL VEHICLES

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

A seasonal vehicle is defined in the *Road Transport (Vehicle Registration) Regulations 2000* as:

A vehicle of a kind declared to be a seasonal vehicle under regulation 31 (Duration of registration) if the vehicle is used during part of the year only.

Seasonal vehicles are those which are included in the vehicle types declared to be seasonal vehicles, and which are used for part of the year only.

The purpose of this instrument is to set the maximum period, in any twelve-month period, for which a seasonal vehicle may be registered. A seasonal vehicle may be registered for not more than nine months in any 12-month period.

The power to make this instrument is contained in subregulation 68(10) of the *Road Transport (Vehicle Registration) Regulations 2000*.

The declaration is a disallowable instrument pursuant to subregulation 68(12) of the *Road Transport (Vehicle Registration) Regulations 2000*.
