# Nature Conservation (Fees) Determination 2018 (No 1)

## Disallowable instrument DI2018-98

made under the

**Nature Conservation Act 2014, s 368 (Determination of fees etc)**

## EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

---

Section 368 of the *Nature Conservation Act 2014* permits the Minister to determine fees for the Act.

The instrument extends the existing waiver of the payment of daily entry fees to the Tidbinbilla Nature Reserve to Reconciliation Day, which occurs on 27 May in any year, or if that day is not a Monday, the following Monday.

The instrument commences on the day after its notification day.

This instrument revokes the *Nature Conservation (Fees) Determination 2017* (DI2017-156).

A determination made under section 368 of the Act is a disallowable instrument and must be presented to the Legislative Assembly within 6 sitting days after its notification pursuant to section 64 of the *Legislation Act 2001*.

### **Regulatory impact statement (RIS)**

A RIS is not required for this fee determination due to section 36 (1) (b) of the Legislation Act, which provides that a RIS need not be prepared for a matter that does not operate to the disadvantage of anyone (other than the Territory or a territory authority or instrumentality).

### **Human rights**

The Standing Committee on Justice and Community Safety (Legislative Scrutiny Role) terms of reference require consideration of human rights impacts, among other matters. In this case, no human rights are impacted.
