EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

Subsection 13(1) of the *Road Transport (General) Act 1999* empowers the Minister to declare that the road transport legislation does not apply to a vehicle, person or animal in a place or circumstance stated in the declaration. Such a notice is a disallowable instrument for the purposes of section 10 of the *Subordinate Laws Act 1989*.

This instrument declares that the road transport legislation does not apply to vehicles and persons competing in the special stages of the 2000 National Capital Rally on Saturday, 14 October 2000. The declaration will also have the effect of minimising the risk of claims against the Territory for injuries arising from the event.

The declaration specifies that the road transport legislation does not apply to:

- (d) the owner of any competing vehicle;
- (e) any competing vehicle; and
- (f) any driver while driving or in control of a competing vehicle.

while the vehicle is being used in a designated activity.

This declaration has effect for the period from 11.00am to 11.30pm on Saturday, 14 October 2000.

For this declaration, the following definitions apply:

- competing vehicle** means any vehicle used or intended to be used for competing in the event.
- competitive route** means a road or road related area used or intended to be used for a designated activity, including an area of land radiating in all directions in a straight line fifty (50) metres from the centre of such a road.
- designated activity** means an activity that forms part, or is intended to form part, of special stages 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9 or 10 of the event.
- driver** means a person who is a driver, co-driver or passenger.
- event** means the 2000 National Capital Rally on Saturday 14 October 2000.

- special stage 1** means the competitive route shown on map 1, commencing at the start point identified by ACT standard grid coordinates (ACTSGC) E20850 and N602890 and finishing at ACTSGC E203250 and N603400.
- special stage 2** means the competitive route shown on map 1, commencing at the start point identified by ACTSGC E202500 and N602950 and finishing at ACTSGC E201650 and N600550.
- special stage 3** means the competitive route shown on map 1, commencing at the start point identified by ACTSGC E200850 and N598900 and finishing at ACTSGC E199780 and N601800.
- special stage 4** means the competitive route shown on map 2, commencing at the start point identified by ACTSGC E183900 and N597400 and finishing at ACTSGC E187800 and N599400.
- special stage 5** means the competitive route shown on map 2, commencing at the start point identified by ACTSGC E192030 and N602040 and finishing at ACTSGC E187800 and N599400.
- special stage 6** means the competitive route shown on map 2, commencing at the start control point identified by ACTSGC E189740 and N601750 and finishing at ACTSGC E188800 and N600530.
- special stage 7** means the competitive route shown on map 3, commencing at the start point identified by ACTSGC E194050 and N588390 and finishing at ACTSGC E193620 and N596040.
- special stage 8** means the competitive route shown on map 3, commencing at the start point identified by ACTSGC E193300 and N596220 and finishing at ACTSGC E193580 and N596090.
- special stage 9** means the competitive route shown on map 4, commencing at the start point identified by ACTSGC E192030 and N602040 and finishing at ACTSGC E187800 and N599400.
- special stage 10** means the competitive route shown on map 5, commencing at the start point identified by ACTSGC E205700 and N603000 and finishing at ACTSGC E205700 and N602900.
