EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The *Motor Traffic Act 1936* under section 27D, allows the Registrar for Motor Vehicles to grant to a person who intends to use a motor vehicle as a restricted taxi licence to operate a vehicle if satisfied that the use of the vehicle will meet a community need and on the payment of the determined fee.

In response to a report issued by the Standing Committee on Urban Services Inquiry into the 'Need to Increase the Number of Restricted Taxi (Multicab) Plates', the Minister has approved the issue an additional ten restricted taxi licences pursuant to section 27E of the *Motor Traffic Act 1936*.

The determined fee for the restricted taxi licences will be six thousand dollars for a six year licence term. One thousand dollars is necessary for the licence to be issued. It is intended that licensees will be able to pay the remainder of the fee in annual instalments of one thousand dollars.
