EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The *Motor Traffic Act 1936* under section 217A, empowers the Minister, by notice in writing published in the *Gazette*, to determine fees and other amounts for the purpose of the Act.

The Motor Traffic (Amendment) Act (No. 2) 1999, makes provision for using various types of traffic offence detection devices in the ACT, including speed cameras and red light cameras. The Act further provides in section 180ZI that an image produced by a traffic offence detection device may be inspected by a person to whom the section applies, or alternatively, upon payment of a determined fee, a copy must be given to the person.

The determined fee is \$10.
