AUSTRALIAN CAPITAL TERRITORY REGISTRATION OF DEEDS ACT 1957 DETERMINATION OF FEES INSTRUMENT NO. 200 OF 2000

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The Registration of Deeds Act 1957 provides for the registration of miscellaneous deeds in the Australian Capital Territory. In particular, section 8 enables the Minister to determine fees for the purposes of the Act.

This Determination revokes Determination of Fees No. 158 of 1999 made on 28 June 1999 and notified in the Australian Capital Territory Gazette No. S38 of 30 June 1999 and determines that the fees payable under the Act shall be as set out in the Schedule to the Determination.

The fee determined for Item 1 has been increased by a margin of 2.5% in accordance with the anticipated movement in 2000/2001 of the Consumer Price Index and with a view to full cost recovery.

The fee determined for Item 2 has been \$15 per page to a maximum of \$45 for the last two financial years and is now increased to \$16 per page to a maximum of \$48 to reflect Consumer Price Index charges on a biennial basis (2.5% for 1999/00 and anticipated 2.5% for 2000/01) and with a view to full cost recovery.
