INSTRUMENT NO. 191 of 2000

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The *Public Sector Management Act 1994* (the Act) provides for the regulation of the Territory's public sector.

The Commissioner for Public Administration, appointed by the Chief Minister under the Act, is a key office in the administration of the ACT Public Service.

The Commissioner:

- advises the Chief Minister on the management of the service;
- implements administrative rearrangements at the direction of the Chief Minister;
and
- performs other functions conferred by the Act or other laws.

This instrument appoints Mr Richard Moss as Commissioner for Public Administration for a period of three years commencing from the date the instrument is notified in the Gazette.

Mr Moss is not a public servant and occupies the position on a part-time basis.

Under the requirements of section 4 of the *Statutory Appointments Act 1994*, the appointment has been the subject of consultation with the Standing Committee for Finance and Public Administration. The Committee has advised it has no objection to the appointment of Mr Moss.
