## **EXPLANATORY STATEMENT**

Under section 208 of the *Legislation Act 2001*, an appointer's power to make an appointment includes the power to end the appointment and appoint someone else.

Mr James Lawton was appointed as a member of the Public Interest Monitor Panel under section 62 of the *Terrorism (Extraordinary Temporary Powers) Act 2006*.
