AMENDMENT TO COMPANIES REGULATIONS 1976 No 31

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

The purpose of these Regulations is to amend the Companies Regulations to take account of the fact that the responsibility for the administration of the Companies Ordinance has been transferred from the Attorney-General to the Minister for Business and Consumer Affairs.

- 2. The amendments replace the references to the Attorney-General that are contained in the following provisions of the Companies Regulations:-
 - regulation 12 which sets out matters and things to be included in a deed relating to interests other than shares and debentures (draft regulation 1);
 - form 51 which sets out the form of notice to be used by an inspector under sub-section 171(3) of the Companies Ordinance (draft regulation 2); and
 - form 91 which sets out the form of notice of intention to apply for exemption from sub-section 374(1) of the Companies Ordinance (draft regulation 3).
