**EXPLANATORY STATEMENT**

The Road Transport (Offences) Regulations, under subregulation 20 (2) empower the Minister to declare a holiday period by notice published in the Gazette. The notice, by virtue of paragraph 20 (3), is a disallowable instrument for the purposes of section 10 of the Subordinate Laws Act 1989.

This instrument specifies that the period from the first moment of Thursday 20 April 2000 to the last moment of Tuesday 25 April 2000 (inclusive), shall be a declared holiday period. Accordingly, for this period, additional demerit points as specified in paragraphs 20(1)(a) and 20(1)(b) will apply.
