## **EXPLANATORY STATEMENT**

Section 68 of the *Tree Protection Act 2005* (the Act) establishes the Tree Advisory Panel. Section 69(1) of the Act provides that the advisory panel consists of 3 or more members appointed by the Minister. Under section 69(2) of the Act, members must be appointed to the advisory panel for a term of at least 1 year and not longer than 2 years.

Section 69(3) of the Act provides that the Minister must not appoint a person to the Tree Advisory Panel unless the person has extensive experience in 1 or more of the following fields:

- (a) arboriculture;
- (b) forestry;
- (c) horticulture:
- (d) landscape architecture;
- (e) natural and cultural heritage.

This instrument appoints Ms Mary Appleby as a member of the Tree Advisory Panel for a period of 2 years.

Ms Appleby holds a Bachelor of Applied Science (Horticulture) and has extensive experience in horticulture.

Ms Appleby is not a public servant. Division 19.3.3 of the *Legislation Act 2001* applies to this appointment. Prior to making this appointment, in accordance with section 228 of the *Legislation Act 2001*, the Minister consulted the Legislative Assembly's Standing Committee on Planning, Transport and City Services who did not object to the appointment.
