## **Agents (Fees) Determination 2024**

## **EXPLANATORY STATEMENT**

The Minister has power to determine fees for the purposes of this Act.

The new determination sets the fees that will apply beginning on 1 July 2024 and repeals the *Agent* (*Fees*) *Determination 2023* DI2023-195. Fees in the 2024 - 2025 financial year have been generally increased from fees in the previous financial year by the Wages Price Index (WPI) of 3.50%, plus an additional 0.35%, rounded down to the nearest dollar. Some smaller value fees maybe rounded up to the nearest dollar. This approach also aligns with the 2023 Treasury Guidelines for Fees and Charges.

Explanatory notes in the determination list the fees previously determined to enable comparison.

The new determination removes the licensing fees for an employment agent licence. *The Housing and Consumer Affairs Legislation Amendment Act* (the HCA Act) amends the *Agents Act 2003* to remove the licensing requirements for employment agents in the ACT. Amendments to the *Agents Act 2003* under the HCA Act commence 1 July 2024.
