EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The *Medicines, Poisons and Therapeutic Goods Act 2008* establishes an authorisation and licensing framework for medicines and poisons.

This instrument revokes and replaces DI2023-263, notified on 23 November 2023.

This instrument sets fees for the application of licences under the Act, as well as for the amendment or replacement of licences. The Determination comes into effect on 1 January 2025 and increases the fees by Wage Price Index of 3.5% (rounded to the nearest 5 cents), as set out below:
