EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The *Canberra Institute of Technology Act 1987* (the Act) and the *Financial Management Act 1996* provide for the establishment and appointment of the governing board members.

This instrument appoints Ms Kylie Walker to be CIT Board Deputy Chair for a period of three years.

This instrument makes an appointment to which the *Legislation Act 2001*, Division 19.3.3, applies and is a disallowable instrument. The Minister for Skills, Training and Industrial Relations has consulted with the Standing Committee on Economics, Industry and Recreation regarding the appointment. The committee has made no comment on the appointment.

Ms Walker is a national leader in science, technology, engineering and research and is skilled in governance and public policy.

Ms Walker has not been appointed to the Board as the CIT staff or student member representative.

Ms Walker is not an ACT public servant.
