Race and Sports Bookmaking (Sports Bookmaking Events) Determination 2026 (No 1)

Race and Sports Bookmaking Act 2001, s20(1) - Determination of sports bookmaking events

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The *Race and Sports Bookmaking Act 2001* (the Act) regulates the activities of sports bookmakers in the Australian Capital Territory.

Subsection 20(1) of the Act provides that the Commission may determine a sporting or other event to be a sports bookmaking event for the purpose of the Act.

This determination revokes DI2015-104 dated 1 June 2015 and notified under the Legislation Register on 5 June 2015.

Schedule 1 of this determination details the various national and international sporting and other events that a sports bookmaking licensee may offer.

Amendments to Schedule 1 of this Instrument include the addition of the Ultimate Fighting Championship as a sanctioning body under the new category of Mixed Martial Arts (Event No 29).

These changes allow sports bookmaking licensees greater flexibility in the events they can offer their customers whilst ensuring that these events are still subject to appropriate regulatory oversight from jurisdictional controlling authorities.

There are no changes made to Schedule 2 of the Instrument.
