### **INSTRUMENT NO. 43 OF 1999**

#### **EXPLANATORY STATEMENT**

The Motor Traffic Regulations, under subregulation 33(4) empower the Minister to declare a holiday period by notice published in the Gazette. The notice, by virtue of paragraph 33(5)(b), is a disallowable instrument for the purposes of section 10 of the Subordinate Laws Act 1989.

This instrument specifies that the period from the first moment of Thursday 1 April 1999 to the last moment of Monday 5 April 1999 (inclusive), shall be a declared holiday period. Accordingly, for this period, additional demerit points as specified in paragraphs 33(1)(a) and 33(1)(b) will apply.
