DETERMINATION OF TAXI FARES
NO. 302 OF 1999
EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

This instrument revokes the previous taxi fare determination under the Motor Traffic Act 1936, namely: -

Determination No. 164 of 1999 dated 1 July 1999 and published in the ACT Gazette No. 27 of 7 July 1999

Taxi fares are regulated under Section 36(1) of the Motor Traffic Act 1936 which specifies that the Minister may, by notice published in the Gazette, determine the maximum fares chargeable for the hiring of a taxi. This notice is a disallowable instrument in the Legislative Assembly.

This determination reflects the capacity to impose a surcharge for taxi hire between 6 PM 31 December 1999 and 12 NOON 1 January 2000.

HIGH OCCUPANCY SURCHARGE

For the carriage of a group of 6 or more passengers to a common hiring destination, that is not the subject of a multiple hiring, the maximum fare is the single rate plus fifty per cent (50%) of that rate.
