### **INSTRUMENT NO. 262 OF 1998**

#### **EXPLANATORY STATEMENT**

The Motor Traffic Regulations, under subregulation 33(4) empower the Minister to declare a holiday period by notice published in the Gazette. The notice, by virtue of paragraph 33(5)(b), is a disallowable instrument for the purposes of section 10 of the Subordinate Laws Act 1989.

This instrument specifies that the period from the first moment of Thursday 31 December 1998 to the last moment of Sunday 3 January 1999 (inclusive), shall be a declared holiday period. Accordingly, for this period, additional demerit points as specified in paragraphs 33(1)(a) and 33(1)(b) will apply.
