PUBLIC SECTOR MANAGEMENT (COMMISSIONER FOR PUBLIC ADMINISTRATION) APPOINTMENT 2003

DISALLOWABLE INSTRUMENT No DI2003-286

Public Sector Management Act 1994

The *Public Sector Management Act 1994* (the Act) provides for the regulation of the Territory's public sector.

The Commissioner for Public Administration, appointed by the Chief Minister under the Act, is a key office in the administration of the ACT Public Service.

The Commissioner:

- advises the Chief Minister on the management of the service;
- implements administrative rearrangements at the direction of the Chief Minister; and
- performs other functions conferred by the Act or other laws.

This instrument appoints Ms Cheryl Vardon as Commissioner for Public Administration for a period of three years commencing on the day after the day the instrument is notified on the Legislation Register.

Ms Vardon is not currently a public servant and will occupy the position on a parttime basis. The Remuneration Tribunal sets remuneration and other terms and conditions.

Under the requirements of division 19.3.3 of the *Legislation Act 2001*, the appointment has been the subject of consultation with the Standing Committee on Public Accounts. The Committee has advised it has no objection to Ms Vardon's appointment.
