EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The *Tenancy Tribunal Act 1994* ("the Act") establishes a new Tenancy Tribunal with jurisdiction to hear disputes and grant relief concerning leases to which the Act applies. Disputes are required, under the Act, to be referred to the Registrar of the Tribunal.

Section 78 of the Act provides for the Minister to determine fees for a number of purposes and, in particular, paragraph 78(1)(a) enables a fee to be determined in respect of a referral of a dispute to the Registrar.

This determination sets a fee of \$100 in respect of each such referral, pursuant to section 12 of the Act.

This fee is consistent with the fee charged under similar dispute resolution legislation in Queensland.
