DETERMINATION OF FEES

NO. 59 OF 1995

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The Associations Incorporation Act 1991 governs the incorporation of non profit associations in the Australian Capital Territory. In particular, section 126 enables the Minister to determine fees for the purposes of the Act and section 125 specifies matters in the Act for which a determined fee is payable.

This Determination revokes Determination of Fees No. 74 of 1994 made on 22 June 1994 and notified in the Australian Capital Territory Gazette No. S127 of 27 June 1994 and determines that the various fees payable under the Act, including fees for lodging for registration and searching documents, shall be as set out in the Schedule to the Determination.

A statement of the old and new fees is attached. In respect of item 6, this fee is determined for the first time.

The fees have generally been increased by 4% in accordance with the anticipated movement in 1995/96 of the Consumer Price Index. Minor fees under \$20 are to be reviewed on a two yearly basis. Fees are set out with a view to full cost recovery and having regard to charges levied for similar interstate services.
