DETERMINATION OF FEES

NO. 64 OF 1995

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The Liquor Act 1975 governs the sale and consumption of liquor in the ACT.

Section 105A of the Act enables the Minister to determine fees for the purposes of the Act.

This Determination revokes Determination of Fees No. 160 of 1994 dated 13 December 1994 and published in the Australian Capital Territory Gazette No. S297 of 19 December 1994 and determines new fees for the purpose of the Act.

A statement of the old and new fees is hereunder.

The fees have generally been increased by 4.0% in line with the anticipated movement in 1995/96 of the Consumer Price Index. The Permit fee is not changed as it is to be the same as the business franchise fee payable under the Business Franchise (Liquor) Act 1993 which is to remain unchanged next financial year. The Proof of Age Card scheme commenced in December 1994 and the fee is not changed.
