DETERMINATION OF FEES

**NO. 66 OF 1995**

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The Real Property Act 1925 governs the registration of dealings in land and the issue of certificates of title for land in the Australian Capital Territory. In particular, subsection 139(1) enables the Minister to determine fees for the purposes of the Act and Schedule 2 specifies the matters in the Act for which a fee may be determined

This Determination revokes Determination of Fees No. 71 of 1994 made on 22 June 1994 and notified in the Australian Capital Territory Gazette No. S127 of 27 June 1994 and determines that the various fees payable under the Act, including fees for lodging for registration and searching documents pertaining to land, shall be as set out in the Schedule to the Determination

A statement of the old and new fees is attached.

The fees have generally been increased by 4% in accordance with the anticipated movement in 1995/96 of the Consumer Price Index. Minor fees under \$20 are reviewed on a two yearly basis. Fees are set with a view to full cost recovery and having regard to charges levied for similar interstate services.
