**REVOCATION AND DETERMINATION OF CHARGES**

NO. 76 OF 1995

**EXPLANATORY STATEMENT**

This instrument revokes all existing determinations under the Motor Omnibus Services Act 1955, namely Determination No 47 of 1994 dated 20 June 1994 published in the Australian Capital Territory Special Gazette No S124 of 27 June 1994, and sets new charges for the purpose of the Motor Omnibus Services Act 1955 as listed in the Schedule to the Determination.

This instrument also introduces a new ticket type for the pensioners/unemployed and seniors category being a \$1.00 fare for daily off-peak travel only.

Details of charges to apply from 1 July 1995 are as follows (former levels are in brackets):
