ROAD RESCUE FEE

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

This Determination sets a Road Rescue Fee for the purpose of the *Motor Traffic Act 1936*. The fee will be charged prior to the registration or renewal of registration of vehicles registered under the *Motor Traffic Act 1936*.

No fee will be charged for those vehicles registered under the veteran, vintage and historic vehicles scheme or for conditionally registered golf carts. This is due to the limited amount of public road access these vehicles are allowed. Diplomatic and Privileged registered vehicles are exempted from payment of the fee under the Vienna Convention. The Road Rescue Fee will not apply to trailers and caravans.

The Road Rescue Fee will not be applied to vehicles registered to permanent residents of the Jervis Bay Territory because the ACT does not provide emergency services to that Territory.

The amount of Road Rescue Fee to be charged for vehicles registered for six months or less will be half the fee charged for 12 months.
