EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The Agents Board of the ACT is a body corporate constituted under the Agents Act 1968 and reports to the Minister for Regulatory Reform

The role of the Board is to act as the licensing authority for the real estate and travel industries in the ACT. In discharging this function, the aim of the Board is to ensure that consumer interests are protected.

The composition of the Board is determined by the Act. The Board consists of seven members all of whom are appointed by the Minister. Members are appointed for periods up to three years as part-time statutory office holders.

The instruments (copies attached) appoint Mr Michael Kumm and Ms Gay Boersma as members of the Board for three years (section 9 (2) of the Act)

These Instruments of Appointment were prepared following consultation with the Legislative Assembly Committee nominated by the Speaker, as required by the Statutory Appointments Act 1994
