INSTRUMENTS ACT 1933 DETERMINATION OF FEES

INSTRUMENT NO. 205 OF 1997

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The Instruments Act 1933 governs the registration of instruments and securities in the Australian Capital Territory. In particular section 37 enables the Minister to determine fees for the purposes of the Act.

This Determination revokes Determination of Fees No. 237 of 1996 made on 16 October 1996 and notified in the Australian Capital Territory Gazette No. S271 of 22 October 1996 and determines that the fees payable under the Act, including fees for lodging for registration and searching documents, shall be as set out in the Schedule to the Determination.

A statement of the old and new fees is attached.

The fees for Item 1 has been increased by a margin of 1 75% in accordance with the anticipated movement in 1997/98 of the Consumer Price Index and with a view to full cost recovery. The fees for other Items have not been increased as the CPI adjustment is less than 50 cents.
