#### **DETERMINATION OF FEES**

NO. 55 OF 1994

#### **EXPLANATORY STATEMENT**

This instrument revokes all existing fees determined under the *Cemeteries Act 1933*, namely:

Determination No. 77 of 22 June 1993 published in Australian Capital Territory Gazette No. S122 of 30 June 1993.

This determination sets fees for the purpose of the *Cemeteries Act 1933* and has the effect of re-determining existing fees and determining fees for new services provided by the Canberra Public Cemeteries Trust on and after 1 July 1994.

Fees have been increased in line with the Consumer Price Index and to effect full cost recovery for the provision of services. Fees are similar to those charged in the States for like services. To create a commercially competitive set of fees for a wide variety of similar ancillary services, the term "by negotiation" has been used in some cases, rather than a specific fee or charge.

One service has been deleted and two new, significant services have been introduced as follows:

Deleted. Children's Rockery.

. <u>New</u>. Plaques for the Ex-Service Portion, previously provided by the RSL.

. <u>New</u>. Provision of concrete burial vaults, previously provided by external sources.

### b. Reservation Fees

A Certificate of Reservation can be purchased entitling the Certificate Holder to an Exclusive Right of Burial at some time during the next 25 years. At the time of purchase of the Certificate, the relevant Allotment Fee and Maintenance Fee must be pre-paid. At the first, or subsequent interments a Maintenance Fee is payable to extend the maintenance period to a full 50 years after the last interment.

Reservation of an un-specified allotment, or the adjacent allotment at the time of a burial (limit of one allotment):

No Reservation Fee.

Reservation of a Specific Allotment in an established part of Cemetery:

Reservation Fee = 50% of relevant allotment fee.

Exclusive Right of Burial and Certificates of Reservation are renewable but will lapse if not renewed prior to the expiration of tenure.

- b. Any coffin or casket which exceeds 2130mm x 710mm is classified as oversize.

A single allotment measures 2500 mm x 1250 mm A double allotment measures 5000 mm x 2500 mm

**Double Allotments** 

a. <u>Headstone Areas</u>. Double monuments may only be constructed on double allotments, and accordingly double permit fees apply. For the purpose of tenure, a double allotment is a single entity.

b., <u>Family Estate</u>. Only double allotments are available in Family Estate areas. Single or double memorials may be constructed subject to the payment of the relevant fee. For the purpose of tenure, a double allotment is a single entity.
