DETERMINATION NO. 60 OF 1994

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

This instrument revokes all existing fees determinations under the *Dangerous Goods Act 1984*, namely:

Determination No 84 of 29 June 1993 published in Australian Capital Territory Gazette No. S127 of 1 July 1993.

The determination sets fees for the purposes of the *Dangerous Goods Act 1984* and has the effect of increasing fees payable for the issuing and renewal of a licence for the keeping, transporting, manufacturing or importing of dangerous goods into the ACT.

The fees have been increased in line with the Consumer Price Index and are shown below, with the existing fees in brackets. The fees reflect the Government's 1994-95 budget strategy and take effect from 1 July 1994.
